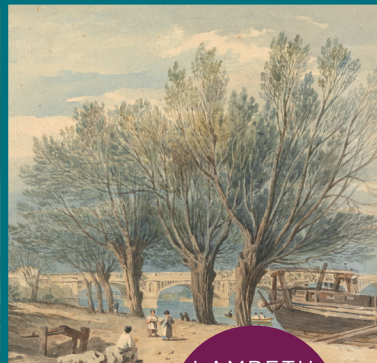
LAMBETH ARCHIVES
